Subject: IMPLEMENTATION OF HOURLY RATE INCREASES FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT PANEL ATTORNEYS (IMPORTANT INFORMATION)

The United States House and Senate Appropriations Committees have approved the Judiciary's final fiscal year 2007 financial plans, which include cost-of-living adjustments to the CJA panel attorney rates, raising the non-capital hourly panel attorney compensation rate from \$92 to \$94, and the maximum hourly capital rate from \$163 to \$166 (for federal capital prosecutions and capital post-conviction proceedings). These rates apply to attorneys appointed to represent eligible persons under the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, and the Antiterrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act of 1996, codified in part in 18 U.S.C. § 3599.

The new hourly compensation rates apply to work performed on or after May 20, 2007. Where the appointment of counsel occurred before this effective date, the new compensation rates apply to that portion of services provided on or after May 20, 2007.
