**MDL Case Management Order No. 2: Clarification Regarding ECF Filing and Counsel
Appearing Pro Hac Vice**

1. This Order shall govern the practice and procedure in those actions transferred to this Court by the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (“Panel”) pursuant to its order of October 21, 2014, entitled TelexFree Securities Litigation, and any tag-along actions transferred by the Panel after that date, and any related actions previously assigned to this Court. This Court will decide the applicability of this Order to any case filed as a related case, on motion of any party in any such case.

2. All counsel appearing on behalf of any party in a case which has been transferred to this Court by the Panel, any related actions previously assigned to this Court and any tag-along actions transferred by the Panel SHALL REGISTER WITH THIS COURT’S ELECTRONIC FILING SYSTEM (“ECF”) AND ALL PLEADINGS AND OTHER PAPERS SUBMITTED TO

THE COURT MUST BE FILED, SIGNED AND VERIFIED BY ELECTRONIC MEANS AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL RULES FOR THE DISTRICT OF MASSACHUSETTS, RULE 5.4.

3. The ECF Registration form may be found at <https://public.mad.uscourts.gov/ecfreg.html>.

As a reminder, in the MDL Case Number field on the ECF Registration Form, counsel shall note both the master MDL case number and the individual Massachusetts case number in which they have an appearance.

4. While counsel who appeared in the transferor District Court prior to the transfer need not enter a separate appearance in this Court or comply with Local Rule 83.5.3(b), counsel who are not admitted in Massachusetts, ***must*** electronically file an affidavit averring that s/he is a member of good standing in every jurisdiction where s/he has been admitted to practice (“affidavit of good standing”) ***and*** must pay the \$100.00 filing fee for appearing *pro hac vice*. No pleadings or other papers shall be filed by counsel not admitted to practice in Massachusetts until the affidavit of good standing has been filed and the fee paid.
