Absent the court's prior approval in exceptional circumstances, parties in patent cases shall be subject to the following briefing page limits.

<u>Summary Judgment</u>: each party shall be limited to 30 pages total in moving brief(s), 30 pages total in opposition brief(s), and 10 pages total in reply brief(s).

<u>Daubert Motions</u>: each party shall be limited to 20 pages total in moving brief(s), 20 pages total in opposition brief(s), and 5 pages total in reply brief(s).

Motions in Limine: each motion in limine shall not exceed 5 pages in length. The court may or may not request a formal response to a motion, or may reserve the issue for trial.
